³¹ BUT PETER INSISTED EMPHATICALLY, “EVEN IF I HAVE TO DIE WITH YOU, I WILL NEVER DISOWN YOU.” AND ALL THE OTHERS SAID THE SAME. ... ⁴³ JUST AS HE WAS SPEAKING, JUDAS, ONE OF THE TWELVE, APPEARED. WITH HIM WAS A CROWD ARMED WITH SWORDS AND CLUBS, SENT FROM THE CHIEF PRIESTS, THE TEACHERS OF THE LAW, AND THE ELDERS. ⁴⁴ NOW THE BETRAYER HAD ARRANGED A SIGNAL WITH THEM: “THE ONE I KISS IS THE MAN; ARREST HIM AND LEAD HIM AWAY UNDER GUARD.” ⁴⁵ GOING AT ONCE TO JESUS, JUDAS SAID, “RABBI!” AND KISSED HIM. ⁴⁶ THE MEN SEIZED JESUS AND ARRESTED HIM. ...

⁴⁷ THEN ONE OF THOSE STANDING NEAR DREW HIS SWORD AND STRUCK THE SERVANT OF THE HIGH PRIEST, CUTTING OFF HIS EAR. ⁴⁸ "AM I LEADING A REBELLION," SAID JESUS, "THAT YOU HAVE COME OUT WITH SWORDS AND CLUBS TO CAPTURE ME? ⁴⁹ EVERY DAY I WAS WITH YOU, TEACHING IN THE TEMPLE COURTS, AND YOU DID NOT ARREST ME. BUT THE SCRIPTURES MUST BE FULFILLED." ⁵⁰ THEN EVERYONE DESERTED HIM AND FLED. ⁵¹ A YOUNG MAN, WEARING NOTHING BUT A LINEN GARMENT, WAS FOLLOWING JESUS. WHEN THEY SEIZED HIM, ⁵² HE FLED NAKED, LEAVING HIS GARMENT BEHIND.
